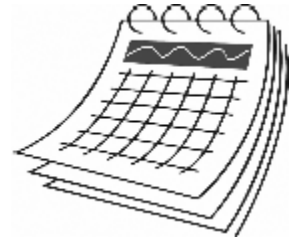

vaccine is approved for ages 16 years and older and is a 2-dose series given 3 weeks apart.
