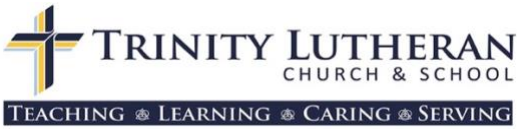
PATCh movie event tonight at 3:30 in the fellowship hall. Popcorn and waters will be provided if you prefer another snack, bring your own.
