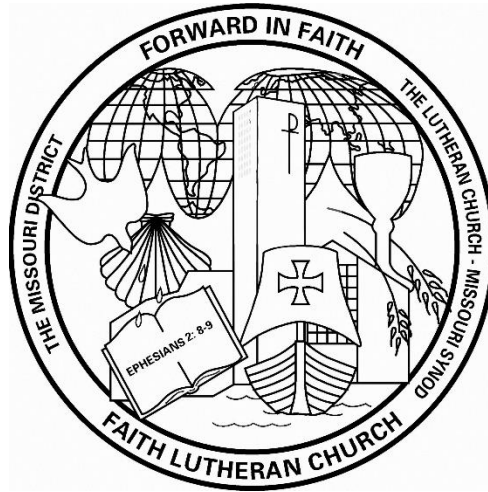

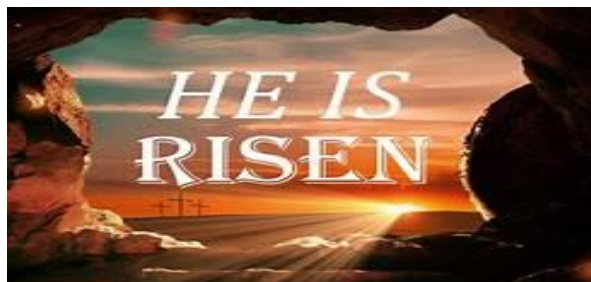

MISSOURI RIGHT TO LIFE

KNOW THE TRUTH!
 Pro-abortion signature-gatherers are seeking to enshrine a “right” to abortion in Missouri’s Constitution all 9 months of pregnancy.

 Missouri law already has a “life of the mother” exception (SMo 188.030). Ectopic & miscarriage procedures are not considered abortion under Missouri law as there is not a “viable unborn child.”

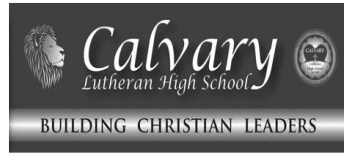
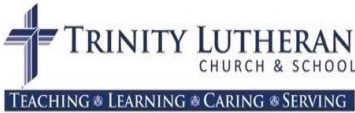
✓ TRUTH
 If a “right” to abortion is enshrined in our Missouri Constitution allowing abortion for physical or mental “health” reasons, abortions can occur from conception until live birth.

✓ TRUTH
 If the amendment passes, women will be denied the right to sue the abortionist for malpractice.

 If a “right” to abortion is enshrined in our Missouri Constitution, it would allow abortions to be performed on pregnant minors without notice to or consent from the minor’s parents.
