## **What will happen to believers at the resurrection?**

*No single passage in Scripture lays out an agenda for the entire Day of*

*Judgment. Each passage has a particular \_\_\_\_\_.*

- *1 Thes. 4:14-17: \_\_\_\_\_ Christians who've lost loved ones.*
- *Matt. 25:31-46: \_\_\_\_\_ judgment without mentioning resurrection.*
- *Daniel 12:1-3; Rev. 20:11-15: Mention both resurrect and judgment but not what happens to \_\_\_\_\_ at resurrection.*
- *1 Cor. 15:35, 51-53: the \_\_\_\_\_ of believers.*
  - *Natural body vs. spiritual body*
  - *Difference between believers and unbelievers. Phil. 3:21.*

## **Matt. 25:31-40. The MERCY of God!**
